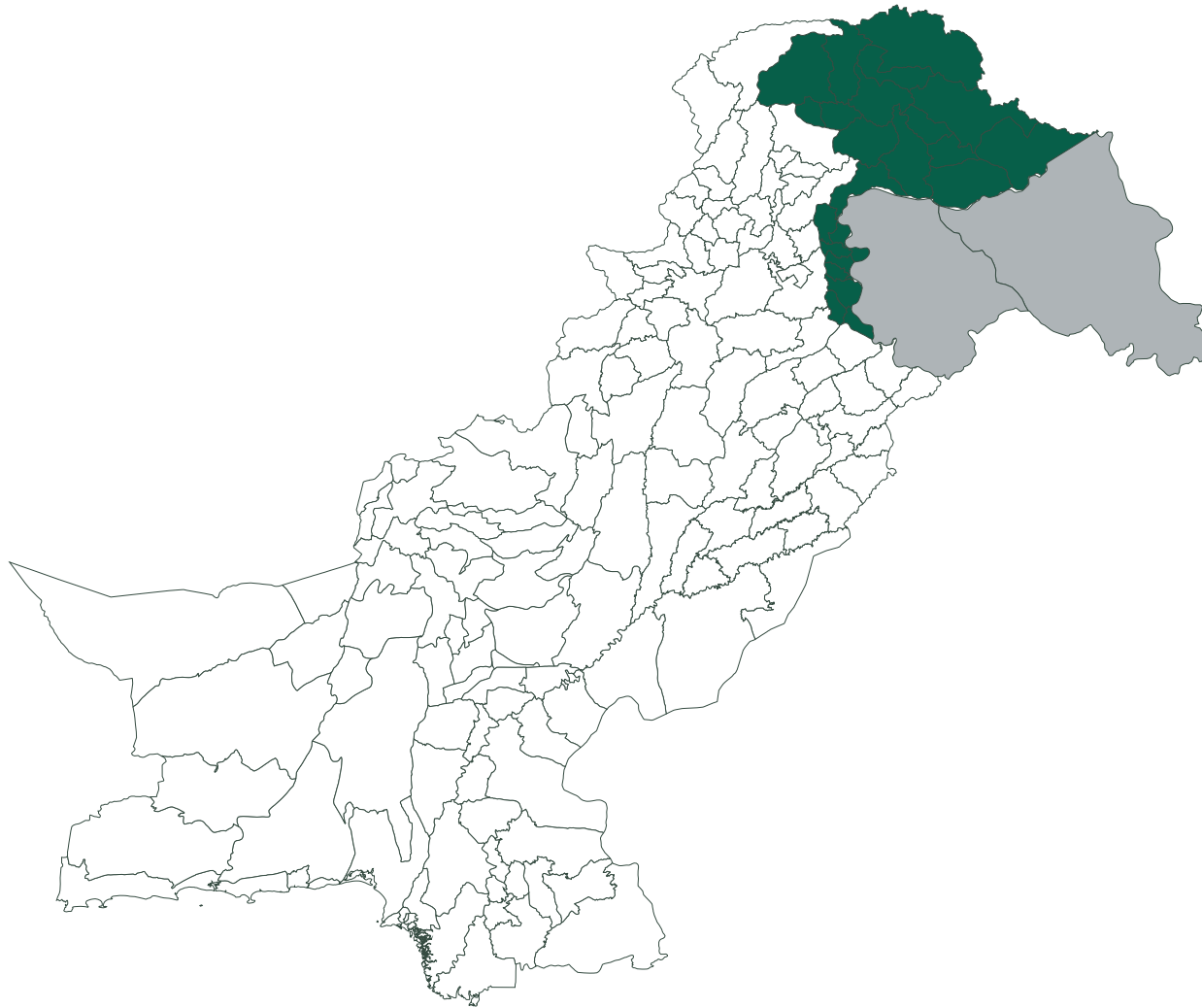


Pakistan, in maps

LOOK CLOSELY

1. Label Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Balochistan.
2. Locate Islamabad and two district names you recognise.
3. Open subaypakistan.org/explore/ and find your district. Record its 2023 population.
4. Which provincial grouping contains it under the 12-province and 36-province models?

Compare the evidence

2023 district population	Lahore: 13,004,135	Multan: 5,362,305
2017 comparison population	Lahore: 11,119,985	Multan: 4,746,166
Households	Lahore: 2,012,526	Multan: 887,304

1. Calculate each district's increase in population between the supplied 2017 and 2023 figures.
2. Calculate the average household size: population divided by households.
3. Why is a district population not necessarily the same as a city population?
4. What evidence would you need before claiming a new province would improve public services?

Teacher notes and answers

Population increase: Lahore 1,884,150; Multan 616,139.

Mean household size: Lahore 6.46; Multan 6.04 people.

Districts are administrative units. A city may occupy part of a district or span several districts.

Ask students to identify missing evidence: administrative costs, revenue, travel times, staffing and public consent. A smaller average population is not evidence of improved services.

The current model displays four provinces and Islamabad separately. The four proposal totals include Islamabad as a separate unit. GB and AJK have separate coverage/status in the project.

Census source: Pakistan Bureau of Statistics (2023), via Muhammad Yaseen / PakPC2023. The snapshot contains 136 district entries. Comparisons use the supplied 2017 base; district boundary changes can affect interpretation.

Map geometry: WFP/OCHA via HDX (2022). These older outlines are not a definitive representation of every 2023 district. CC BY-IGO. Dashed reference outlines use the online district chooser where current borders remain unresolved.
